Douglas LaBrecque, MD received his B.S. degree in biology from Boston College and his medical degree from Stanford Medical School. He trained in Internal Medicine at Duke Medical Center, was a fellow in hepatology with Gerald Klatskin at the Yale Medical School and served as a staff fellow at the National Cancer Institute. He has previously served as chief of gastroenterology/hepatology at the Iowa City Veterans Affairs Hospital for 19 years. Currently, Dr. LaBrecque serves as professor of medicine at the University of Iowa. He built and directed the liver service at the UI for 30 years, where he helped found the Liver Transplantation Program. He is the lead hepatology expert for this ECHO program.
